About the Font

We are very pleased to announce the release of LL Geigy, Robert Huber's new typeface. Geigy is inspired by graphic design produced in Switzerland in the decade before the global success of Helvetica and Univers eclipsed much of the aesthetically less standardised work of the era.

Robert Huber was particularly intrigued by the title lettering of a corporate periodical for Geigy, Switzerland's leading pharmaceutical company in the post-war era. The publication's masthead, 'Geigy Berater' (translating as 'Geigy Consultant'), and its layout were recreated by Karl Gerstner in 1953. More hand-drawn and custom-made applications in a similar whimsical style are found throughout the 1950s in posters, signage, logos, book covers and printed matter from various designers operating in Basel, and across Switzerland.

The playfully dynamic and extravagant curves of these shapes form an eccentric counterpoint to the usually sober and austere sans-serifs of the era. A pronounced thick-thin contrast and tightly closed letterforms with horizontal terminals, paired with compact metrics, became the

backbone and starting point of the design for LL Geigy. Robert dedicated more than three years to the detailed elaboration of his rendering, and the family currently consists of four weights with italics, including some sets of alternates. Thanks to a sophisticated balance between proportions, dimensions, metrics and the particular shapes of individual letters, LL Geigy offers a high level of recognition for titles, while fully responding to functional criteria when used in small.

Two monospaced weights to complement the family, lead Robert into largely uncharted territory. Monospaced sans serifs with pronounced contrast are unusual, as some of the rounded upper-case shapes become even more conspicuous when narrowed, while some lower-case letters become even more curvy through the widening. Again, Robert succeeded to fuse an experimental approach with sustained functionality, paying homage to a free-spirited aspect of mid-century typography from Switzerland which hasn't yet found much recognition. A variable, duplexed version of LL Geigy is in the making and is already available per request.

All three Swiss companies prospered and continued to diversify in the decades after World War II, though Sandoz earned an unwelcome notoriety in the 1960s when one of its inventions, a potent hallucinogen called LSD, became a favourite illicit drug in the United States and

Europe. In 1970 Ciba and Geigy merged to form Ciba-Geigy AG, and in 1996, in the midst of a wave of consolidations and mergers sweeping the pharmaceutical industry, this company merged with Sandoz AG to form one of the largest drug companies in the world. This merger was one

of the largest in corporate history up to that time. Novartis AG has affiliates in about 140 countries and is engaged in the development, manufacture, and marketing of pharmaceuticals, herbicides and insecticides, over-the-counter medications, veterinary medicines, and garden products.

The Ciba-Geigy Chemical Corporation site in Toms River, Dover Township, New Jersey, was owned and operated by the Ciba Specialty Chemicals Corporation which was formerly the GIBA-GEIGY CHEMICAL CORPORATION (GIBA-GEIGY) AND IN APRIL 2009, BASF BOUGHT CIBA SPECIALTY Chemicals. The site encompasses approximately 1,400 acres, 320 of which are developed, with the remainder consisting of cleared areas, Pine Barrens and wetlands. From 1952 TO 1990, CIBA-GEIGY MANUFACTURED DYES, PIGMENTS, RESINS AND EPOXY ADDITIVES. ALL COMMERCIAL OPERATIONS at the site ceased in December 1996 and most of the manufacturing buildings were subsequently demolished. Sludge and process wastes were disposed of in several locations ON THE SITE, INCLUDING A STACKED DRUM DISPOSAL AREA ORIGINALLY BELIEVED TO CONTAIN APPROXI-
